A mandatory internship gives you the opportunity to apply your knowledge in a professional environment while building valuable industry connections before graduation.

Graduates pursue careers as cybersecurity specialists, security consultants, IT security managers and other roles within both public and private organisations across Denmark and Europe.

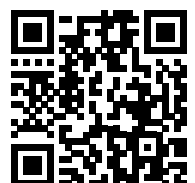

Admission

Admission requirements vary by programme.

Tuition Fees

Students from Denmark, Scandinavia and the EU/EEA study tuition-free. Programme-specific tuition fees apply for non-EU/EEA applicants.

Study costs

Books and study materials typically cost between DKK 1,000–5,000 per year, depending on your programme.

Danish Student Support (SU)

Eligible EU/EEA students may qualify for Danish student support by working approximately 10–12 hours per week. Many students find a part-time job during their first semester.

Working while you study

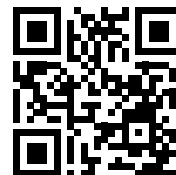
International students are generally allowed to work up to 15 hours per week during the semester and full-time during the summer holidays, subject to Danish immigration rules. A part-time job is a great way to gain experience, but you should not rely on it as your only source of income.

Residence & Entry

EU/EEA students apply for residence after arriving in Denmark. Non-EU applicants must obtain the required permits before the study start (first day).
