Bachelor in Cybersecurity

Protect the digital world

Cybersecurity is a rapidly growing field, creating strong demand for professionals who can protect organisations, infrastructure and society from increasingly complex cyber threats.

At Zealand, you'll learn how to design secure digital solutions, identify vulnerabilities and respond to cyber incidents. You'll work with areas such as network security, ethical hacking, security operations and AI, combining technical knowledge with practical projects and collaboration with companies.

Throughout the programme, you'll develop the analytical and problem-solving skills needed to understand risks, respond to new threats and navigate an everchanging digital landscape.

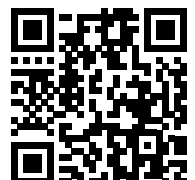
A mandatory internship gives you the opportunity to apply your knowledge in a professional environment while building valuable industry connections before graduation.

Bachelor in Architectural Technology and Construction Management

Build the sustainable cities of tomorrow

The construction industry is changing rapidly, with growing demand for professionals who can combine technical knowledge, digital tools, project management and sustainable construction.

This programme prepares you to coordinate and manage construction projects from planning to completion. You'll work with areas such as building technology, Building Information Modelling (BIM), digital construction, sustainability and construction management while learning to collaborate across disciplines with architects, engineers and contractors.

Through practical assignments, collaboration with companies and a mandatory internship, you'll apply your knowledge to real-world projects and gain valuable industry experience before graduation.

Graduates can pursue careers in construction companies, architectural practices, engineering consultancies and public organisations, working with the design, planning and management of construction projects in Denmark and for Danish companies operating internationally.

Danish applicants: 5 July at 12:00 (CEST / UTC+2)

Admission

Admission requirements vary by programme.

Tuition Fees

Students from Denmark and the EU/EEA study tuition-free. Tuition fees apply to most students from outside the EU/EEA.

Study costs

Books and study materials typically cost between DKK 1,000–5,000 per year, depending on your programme.

Danish Student Support (SU)

Eligible EU/EEA students may qualify for Danish student support by working approximately 10–12 hours per week. Many students find a part-time job during their first semester.

Working while you study

EU/EEA students can work in Denmark while studying. Students from outside the EU/EEA with a relevant student residence and work permit are generally allowed to work up to 90 hours per month from September to May and full-time in June, July and August.

A part-time job can be a good way to gain experience and build your professional network, but you should not rely on it as your only source of income.

Residence & Entry

EU/EEA students apply for residence after arriving in Denmark. Non-EU applicants must obtain the required permits before the study start (first day).
